## DETAILED DESCRIPTION:

### INVITATION

The tasks to be completed by the new privates:

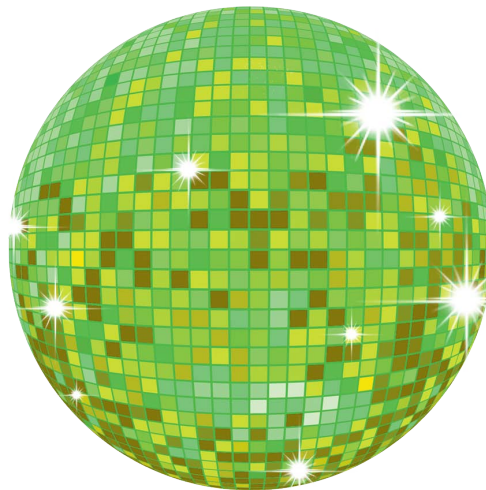
- The soldier's workout: doing push-ups (if a soldier fails to do at least one push-up, the whole unit has to run a kilometer as a punishment).
